## Did Jesus Know the Bible?

Did you ever wonder if Jesus had a HOLY BIBLE to use? What do you think? Yes, we know that he studied the HOLY BIBLE and even memorized it. Of course, Jesus only had the Old Testament to use. Why couldn't he read from the New Testament? When Jesus was a child, he studied the Scriptures like the other Jewish boys. A rabbi or teacher showed him how to read Hebrew, the language in which the Old Testament was written. When the boys were about twelve years old, they were ready to read from the scroll of the HOLY BIBLE in front of the entire congregation.



As Jesus grew older, he studied and learned more about the HOLY BIBLE until he became a rabbi. In Luke 4:14-17 we find that Jesus also taught in the churches much like our pastors do today. Jesus spent the last three years of his life teaching and preaching.


